ACTIVITY OPTIONS

Activity Option 1: A Place for You!

What you need:

Activity Page (attached below), construction paper, crayons/markers, scissors, glue

What you do:

Print out the Activity sheet “Placemat”. Color the silverware, plate, and glass. Cut out all the pieces. Then glue the pieces on to a large piece of construction paper. Make sure the child writes their name on their place setting. (If you don’t have printer access use the document as a guide and create your own on a blank sheet of construction paper.)

Adaptation: Print out Activity Sheet, and color. Make sure the child writes their name on their place setting.

What to say:

One day we will get to have a special dinner with Jesus in Heaven. It is a celebration for people who choose to follow God and have a relationship with Him. That will be such an incredible time. I am so glad that God loves us so much and has invited us to come and eat and celebrate with him at his table. Let’s get our placemats ready and think about what that party might be like.

ACTIVITY OPTIONS

Activity Option 2: A Special Celebration Dinner

What you need:

Table decorations, fancy clothes, food

What you do:

Decorate your table, bring out your fanciest dishes, dress up in your prettiest clothes, and make an extra special dinner. One that you would normally eat on a special occasion. Pray together thanking God for the food. Serve the food. Eat together as a family.

What you say:

Remind and explain to the children that because of what Jesus has done for us, we are all invited to accept Jesus as our Savior. We can accept His very kind invitation, if we want to. This is something we each get to decide for ourselves. One day in Heaven there will be the Wedding Supper of the Lamb, and all of those who have accepted Jesus as their Savior will be at that Big Party in Heaven. What a great day that will be!



TALK ABOUT IT

Discussion Questions:

One day in Heaven there's going to be a BIG celebration for Jesus and His Bride...The Church!

- Who is the Church made up of?

- All the people who have ever believed in Jesus!
- What does that mean for us?
 - It means that all of us who have trusted in Jesus as our Savior will be with Him forever in Heaven.
- How should the church prepare for Jesus?
 - Jesus is preparing The Church (His Bride) for Himself. He has done all the hard work of getting us ready. The Bible tells us that Jesus died to make the church holy. And will continue to prepare us through His Word.
