## **Activity: Forgiveness of Sins**

### **What you need:**

Paper, pencil, and eraser

### **What to say:**

Have you ever made a mistake? I've made a great many in my lifetime. What kind of mistakes have you made? Write them down on your paper with the pencil. Now erase what you wrote!

Erasers make it possible for us to start over and correct our mistakes.

God forgives us when we confess our sins and our mistakes, and He makes things clean and fresh in our lives, just like the eraser does on the paper. In fact, the Bible says in Hebrews 10:17 "I will not remember their sins anymore. I will not remember the evil things they have done."

Remember, Jesus died for us, to ERASE our sins away. Each time you look at an eraser, thank God for sending Jesus to die on the cross and forgives us of our sins.

## TALK ABOUT IT

### **Discussion Questions:**

- How many times do you think a person should be forgiven for doing something wrong? Once? Twice? Three times?
- Do you carry guilt around with you over a sin you have committed?

We all have guilt from time to time, over our wrong doings. The next time you feel guilt creeping up or the next time Satan tries to remind you of some past sin that you still don't feel like God has forgiven, or the next time you sin this week and the guilt starts growing, remind yourself that Jesus died for that sin! He has forgiven you!

Spend time this week marveling at Jesus. Worship him, and continually seek the Lord in prayer and ask Him to help you overcome any guilt you might be holding onto. Ask God to help you understand His grace and to help you fully trust in Christ.
